NC National Guard – Army Aviation Support Facility - \$6.787 million

The North Carolina National Guard (NCNG) is seeking federal funding for the design and construction of a new, expanded Army Aviation Support Facility to manage the aircraft assigned to the NCNG. Located in Morrisville, the Army Aviation Support Facility provides essential support, protection, and maintenance for a large fleet of helicopters and planes used by the NCNG to conduct its missions. Since it was constructed in 1988, the number of aircraft and aircraft personnel assigned to the Facility has increased considerably, but it has not been expanded or upgraded to meet this capacity. Additionally, the facility has been strained by the needs of newer aircraft for which the facility was not originally designed. Federal funding will expand the Support Facility's capacity so that it can accommodate the current fleet and extend the useful life of the aircraft assigned to the Guard.
